DMAP E-Mail Notification

The Delaware Medical Assistance Program (DMAP) has a feature that will aid in communicating changes to interested parties. All providers are encouraged to register for the DMAP e-mail notification service. You do not need to be a DMAP provider to register. Any person may register to receive the latest DMAP notifications, including multiple persons from the same office.

How it works: Once you have registered for the DMAP e-mail notification service, you will automatically receive an e-mail notification any time a new document or update has been added to the DMAP Website. Users will be able to select the types of communications they wish to receive ranging from bulletins/alerts, provider manual updates, client communications and pharmacy communications. All information that would normally be mailed to DMAP providers will still be mailed as usual. This tool will allow the DMAP to communicate other important information to all users such as policy changes, public meeting notices, State closings, weather delays, or other important information.

How to register: Go to the DMAP website (<http://www.dmap.state.de.us>) and click on the link for DMAP e-mail registration. Next, click Register at the bottom of the page. Fill in your e-mail address, confirm your e-mail address, and fill in your name or business. Now, simply follow the instructions on the screen to complete registration and begin receiving the latest notifications!

Use of this tool enables the DMAP to communicate changes to registered users as soon as they are posted to the Internet! The DMAP e-mail notification service will ensure that the DMAP is taking every possible measure to effectively communicate important changes to the community.
